Dear Church family,


Summer has arrived and we celebrated once again with our yearly Pentecost procession around the parking lot and back into the church nave. This time we had an electronic mishap with

They dropped the petals during the part that said "divided tongues, as of fire, appeared among them, and a tongue rested on each of them". Titan Environmental Services



On April 13, 2023 Tristan O'Brien from Titan Environmental Services did air and surface testing throughout the church. Also tested was inside the exterior hole in the fascia by the Sacristy for Histoplasma capsulatum (bird droppings). Many samples were taken and sent out to their lab to be analyzed. An extensive 38-page report has been shared with the Vestry by Properties Chair Carl Turlin. Carl will prioritize the suggestions for treating their findings and report back to the Vestry for their consideration. Pollen, dander and some mold were all mentioned.
